Note 1	Membership subscriptions are due annually on 1st January ;																
Note 2	Any member who has not renewed their membership by 25th January will cease to enjoy any Society benefits; Society benefits include Public Liability Insurance up to £5m , Product Liability Insurance and Bee Disease Insurance (see Note 8 below);																
Note 3	Membership of the Society can be Single (Individuals) £25.00 (£20.00 if renewed/paid for by 31st December) or Joint (Families or Partners) £30.00 (£25.00 if renewed/paid for by 31st December);																
Note 4	When completing this form for <u>Joint Membership</u> please include the names of all applicants;																
Note 5	Data Protection: A condition of membership is your agreement to your membership details being held electronically. This information will be used for the efficient running of the Society, by the officials. Appropriate information will be passed to the WBKA for the purposes of insurance and distribution of their magazine; it will also be shared with BDI for the purpose of disease insurance and with the APHA Bee Inspectors to assist them in the control of bee diseases;
